This delicious red blend comes from the Columbia Valley, a region known for fruit-forward, balanced, and drinkable wines on release. Aromas of ripe, dark fruit are dotted by hints of red fruit on the nose. Notes of black cherry and plum make for a fruit-forward palate with soft tannin throughout.
